About the Role

We are looking for a motivated Inventory Coordinator to join our team. The Inventory Coordinator is responsible for reviewing crops for readiness and communicating with the sales department, site supervisors, and shipping for allocations.

This is an **in-person** role based out of our **Mission, BC** office. Some minor travel is required for this role, to go between sites to review inventory.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Review orders for shipment 3 – 4 weeks in advance
- Coordinate material from different locations to ensure supply for customers
- Allocate Sales orders as they get entered, grade and prorate entry allocations
- Review Phytos after Sales has entered and act as back-up for writing phyto-certificates
- Assign priorities to the new transplants at the end of the month for future sales/shifts
- Review crops in order to help determine salability/expiration
- Update inventory daily with new transplants, movements, dead plants, etc.
- Enter/adjustment of orders as needed
- Support Sales Department with any concerns with orders
- Maintain the integrity of the availability of products by ensuring inventory is accurate
- Communicate with Growers and Site Supervisors for sold crops and maintenance timing a few weeks before shipment
- Update Transfers/Dump sheets as needed
- Run reports as needed
- Follow all safe job procedures
- Other duties as assigned
